COLUMBIA PARK ENTRANCE MAKEOVER

We are a few months into the new gate system at our Columbia Road entrance. We thank all our residents who have taken the time to learn the new system. The Residents, Guests, and Exit gates are working. There have been a few bumps in the road, but we have worked our way through them. It is very important to remember to let your visitors and delivery people know that they need to either use the assigned 4-digit code (yours for friends and family and designated ones for delivery people) or call you from the call box to let them in. We have found that one of the biggest delays occurs when guests and delivery people are not given a code to use when they arrive. You can stop by the office for the list if needed. We have also lowered the call box by six inches, so it should be accessible to people in smaller cars. Each day is getting a little smoother. In a few months, everyone will be used to the new system, and we anticipate smooth sailing going forward. Thank you again for your patience during this transition.

The Fitch Road gate is being transferred from the key card system to the same system that reads the windshield stickers used at the front gates. Everyone will be able to enter through the back gate as long as they have the sticker. This is scheduled to be done the first week of June.


DOG OF THE MONTH
