#### COLUMBIA PARK ENTRANCE MAKEOVER

We are three months into the new gate system at our Columbia Road entrance. We thank all our residents who have taken the time to learn the new system. The Residents, Guests, and Exit gates are working well. There have been a few bumps in the road, but we have worked our way through them.

It is very important to remember to let your visitors and delivery people know that they need to either use the assigned 4-digit code (yours for friends and family and designated ones for delivery people) or call you from the call box to let them in. We have found that one of the biggest delays occurs when guests or delivery people are not given a code to use upon arrival. You can stop by the office for the list if needed.

We have also lowered the call box by six inches to make it accessible to people in smaller cars. Each day is getting a little smoother. In a few months, everyone will be used to the new system, and we anticipate smooth sailing going forward. Thank you again for your patience during this transition.

## **ONLINE TAX PAYMENTS NOW AVAILABLE**

The Cuyahoga County Treasurer's Office is now accepting online tax payments for all mobile home residents. Cuyahoga County is pleased to have put this into place for our taxpayers. Please share this information with your residents.

Important Reminder: Second half taxes are due July 31, 2024. The Point & Pay System will be up and running for the mobile home second half tax collection. Below are some prompts to follow:

To pay by phone using e-check, credit card, or debit card: Call (877) 738-1212

- When prompted to enter the parcel number, DO NOT ADD THE DASHES IN BETWEEN THE PARCEL NUMBERS. Use asterisks in place of the dashes (e.g., 001023456).
- We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and American Express.
- For customer service, call (888) 891-6064 and choose option 1.

## To pay in person:

- Visit our office Cuyahoga County Administration Headquarters at 2079 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 1-100, Cleveland, Ohio 44115.
- You also have the option to use the drop box located along the wall outside the main doors. All Cuyahoga Title Bureaus will have a drop box for residents to drop off payments as well.
